






Refugees banned from their Homeland:

At the time of opening the doors of immigration to European Jewish settlers, who flocked in numbers exceeding 510 thousand since the British occupation of Al-Quds in 1917 until 1948; the British cooperated with the Zionists to displace the largest possible number of Palestinian residents by all terrorist means. Especially after the 1947 partition resolution, the number of displaced Palestinians reached more than 850 thousand when the establishment of the Zionist entity was announced. Then, 1967 witnessed the second large wave of displacement, which included up to 460 thousand Palestinians.

The occupation government is implementing illegal policies aimed at seizing important areas, especially in Al-Quds, and is carrying out deportations, displacement, seizing homes, and destroying residential communities in many rural areas. The Jewish State Law of 2018 also paves the way for depriving about two million Palestinians of the right to self-determination and turning them into refugees.

Currently, the number of Palestinians in the world is approximately 14.5 million, about 7.3 million of whom live as refugees outside the Palestinian territories.







A Nation Captivated in their Homeland:

Contrary to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, "Israeli" law dictates that any Palestinian can be arrested without charge, and without "having participated directly or indirectly in hostile acts;" Therefore, it is not surprising that the number of detainees between 1967 and 2022 reached about one million Palestinians.

Since the beginning of 2023, the Israeli occupation forces have arrested more than 5,000 people, including 83 women and 678 children. By September, more than 5,200 detainees were counted, detained in dozens of prisons, less than %60 of them are convicted.

About 560 detainees are sentenced to life imprisonment, and 23 have been detained since before the signing of the 1993 Oslo Accords, the oldest of whom is (Muhammad Al-Tus), who

has been detained since 1985, in addition to 11 veteran detainees who were freed in 2011 and re-arrested in 2014, the most prominent of whom is "Nael Al-Barghouti" who has entered his 43rd year in the occupation prisons. Among the detainees we find 38 women, about 170 minors, 1,264 administrative detainees, 17 journalists, and 3 deputies.

Administrative Detention, Open Detention without Lawful Justification:

It is detaining a person without a specific charge, based on secret files without providing any evidence. According to the official website of the United Nations, "The Israeli army can detain Palestinians for a period of six months, renewable indefinitely. Judicial review is available, but it is conducted by an Israeli military judge, where minimum international standards of rights, evidence and procedural fairness do not apply."

The occupation authorities issued more than 13,000 administrative detention orders during the past nine years, including 2,350 orders from the beginning of 2023 until September of the same year, including 1,245 new orders and 1,105 renewal orders.

By mid-September, the number of administrative detainees had reached more than 1,264, representing %25 of the total Palestinian detainees, including more than 20 children and four female detainees. While administrative detainees have carried out more than 410 hunger strikes since 2011.




Al-Quds, a Stolen City and Civilization:

For centuries, the city of Al-Quds remained a holy Christian Islamic city, with a Jewish minority living in complete harmony, in contrast to the European persecution of the Jews.

Today, the Zionist entity is trying, through illegal means, to Judaize the city, and to destroy the civilizational and cultural monuments that are linked to the original identity of the city, to give it a racist Zionist character. Therefore, it is taking steps that violate international laws, such as:

- 1- Confiscation of public lands, property of displaced Palestinians, and sources of natural resources.
- 2-Building illegal settlements in and around the Holy City, to change the demographic nature and isolate it from its Palestinian surroundings.
- 3-Demolishing Palestinian homes and real estate and displacing their residents, such as the Sheikh Jarrah and Silwan neighbourhoods.
- 4-The ongoing incursions on Al-Aqsa Mosque and the restriction of religious freedom for Muslims and Christians.
- 5-Arbitrary detention of the people of Al-Quds, and restrictions on freedom of movement, media and culture.
- 6-Illegal excavations under Al-Aqsa Mosque and changing the features of historical places, including cemeteries.
- 7- Obstructing the work of Palestinian education and health institutions, spreading unemployment and drugs, and imposing heavy taxes on the Palestinians.


The Right of Return and Settlement Expansion:

Despite the viciousness of the vanishing apartheid regime in South Africa, the Zionist entity is far superior to it, confirming Noam Chomsky's statement: "There is nothing more brutal and extremist than settler colonialism as an imperial project".

The Zionist entity is not only working to end the Palestinian issue, but rather aims to eliminate the Palestinian people - as a nation with a homeland- and dissolve them in countries of asylum. Usurping entity considers "the right of return" an existential threat to it, as it is a right proven by the Charter of Human Rights, in addition to United Nations General Assembly Resolution No. 1948/11/12,194, which has been confirmed more than 135 times by UN resolutions.

Palestinian Women are Victims of Zionist Violence:

The number of Palestinian women in the occupied territories in 2023 reached 2.70 million, representing %49 of the population, with women heading about %12 of Palestinian families.


More than 16,000 Palestinian women have been arrested under political pretexts from 1967 until today. The number of female detainees today is 38, the oldest of whom is "Maysoon Musa", who has been detained since 2015. Among them are:

- 9 wounded: the most prominent is "Israa Jaabis", who suffers from severe deformities.
- 13 mothers: such as "Etaf Jaradat", the mother of three detainees, and the administrative detainee "Fatima Abu Shalal", the mother of the administrative detainee "Ahmed Abu Shalal".

Many mothers were arrested when they were pregnant and gave birth to children who lived with them in prison for two years, such as "Aisha Al-Kurd", who gave birth in captivity in 1988 to her son "Yasser", who was martyred in 2014 as a result of the Zionist aircraft bombing the family home.

The year 2022 witnessed the detaining of 172 women, and the martyrdom of 18 others, while in 83 ,2023 Palestinian women were detained, 14 of whom are still in prison at the end of September.

Children in Detention:


While UNICEF estimates that "about 700 are the number of Palestinian children between 12 and 17 years of age who are detained annually," Human Rights Watch confirms that these children are treated "with methods capable of terrorizing and traumatizing adults."


During 2022, the Israelis detained about 882 children, including 654 children from Al-Quds, and the number of minor detainees at the end of 2022 reached about 150 boys and girls, in addition to several children from Al-Quds who are detained in private social centres.

In addition to being subjected to random arrest, detained children are deprived of their legitimate rights, such as knowing the reason behind their detention, obtaining a lawyer, contacting their families, and appearing before a judge.

Many Palestinian children were born inside prisons and lived there for long months, which left indelible health and psychological effects on them.

In addition to the Administrative Detention Law, which allows the detention of children for a renewable period of six months without specific charges, we find the "Israeli" Military Juvenile Court designated for children trials and issuing long sentences. The Knesset is also discussing a draft law that allows the issuance of all adult sentences on Palestinians under the age of 12 years.








Illnesses, Imprisonment, and Torment:

The number of sick detainees by the end of 2022 reached more than 600 detainees who face extremely difficult health conditions, with complete deprivation of means of hospitalization, in addition to inhumane prison conditions.

Among them are 200 male and female detainees suffering from chronic diseases, 24 suffering from tumours and cancer, 6 paralyzed detainees, 33 eye patients, 34 suffering from kidney diseases, 120 injured by occupation bullets, 58 suffering from heart diseases, 16 with blood and vessel diseases, 79 with bone diseases, 45 suffer from psychological and neurological diseases, and 27 suffer from respiratory problems, in addition to dozens who suffer from dental problems and other diseases such as diabetes, high blood pressure, and burns, in addition to sick and pregnant women who are detained.

In addition to the hundreds of detainees who were martyred shortly after their liberation due to diseases they inherited from prisons, more than 235 martyrs died inside prisons from 1967 until May 2023. Bodies of 12 of them are still detained, the last of whom are the martyrs "Nasser Abu Hmaid" and "Khoder Adnan"



Cemeteries of Numbers:


A group of secret graves, in which the occupation holds the bodies of hundreds or thousands of martyrs who were killed in battles, or in Zionist prisons, since 1948, where each grave is marked with a number indicating the martyr's secret file held by Israeli intelligence.


These cemeteries include Palestinian, Lebanese, Arab, and foreign martyrs. They are distributed over most of the Palestinian territories, and only the locations of approximately five of them are known, such as:

- 1- The "Banat Yacoub" Bridge Cemetery, which contains about 500 graves of martyrs of the 1982 war and its aftermath.
- 2- A cemetery in the" Jordan Valley," which contains about 100 graves bearing numbers from 5107-5003.

The usurping entity army also has secret maps of dozens of mass graves, which contain victims of the Zionist gang massacres in 1948 and the bodies of Arab martyrs in the battles of 1967 and 1973.

Several Zionist entities contribute to the organs trading of detained martyrs, including the Forensic Medicine Institute in Abu Kabir. The Zionists have detained more than 370 Palestinian martyrs - including children - in refrigerators or graves bearing numbers from 2015 until today.









Al-Aqsa Flood:

A liberation battle launched by the Izz al-Din al-Qassam Brigades, accompanied by Palestinian resistance factions from Gaza and the West Bank, with comprehensive support from resistance factions in Lebanon, Iraq and Yemen, in response to the grave dangers that now threaten Al-Aqsa Mosque, and in response to the calls of thousands of detainees, and in an effort to break the deadly Zionist-imposed siege on the Gaza Strip, denouncing the humiliating normalization approach, and emphasizing the option of resistance until the liberation of all of Palestine.

Al-Aqsa flood achieved great strategic goals, as it demonstrated the weakness of the Zionist army, its secret intelligence failure, the disintegration of the Zionist social and political structure, and the usurping entity's absolute dependence on the support of colonial countries, which was manifested in its ugliest form in this battle, and contributed with the Zionist army to committing one of the greatest war crimes. In modern history, which included massacres, widespread destruction, and genocide of the Palestinians in Gaza, and also affected the camps in the West Bank and southern Lebanon.

Despite the complete Western political, military and media complicity with the usurping entity, the Al-Aqsa flood raised movements of unprecedented global popular solidarity with Gaza and restored the Palestinian cause to the forefront of the international scene.

Massacres as a Controlling Method:

Historical statistics indicate 75 massacres had been carried out by Zionist gangs between 1948-1937, in which more than 5,000 Palestinians were killed. However, the discovery of mass graves again - such as the six cemeteries in Yaffa in 2013, and the Caesarea cemetery in 2022 - shows that the list of massacres is much longer.

Added to the above are dozens of massacres carried out or supported by the usurping entity army in Syria, Lebanon, Egypt, Jordan, and in Palestine from 1948 until today.

The documents recently revealed about the Kafr Qasem massacre in 1956 confirm that committing massacres against civilians was not the result of momentary actions, but rather constituted a basic approach for the Zionist forces with the aim of emptying the land of its people. This is an approach that we still see in the devastating attacks on Gaza and the Jenin camp, which are met by the United States. The United Nations and the European Union supported it, under the pretext of self-defence, as they did with the horrible massacres during the battle of Al-Aqsa Flood, and in all previous massacres, including those committed by the Zionist army against civilians who took refuge in United Nations buildings, as happened in Qana and Gaza several times.









An Entity based on Imprisonment:

The list of known Zionist prisons includes more than twenty internment camps, in addition to several secret prisons, only some of which have been revealed, such as Detention 1391. They are all filled to multiple times their capacity, which turns severe overcrowding in them into another punishment added to the grave violations practiced by the Prison Service against detainees, which amount to Levels of war crimes and crimes against humanity.

These violations include arbitrary and administrative detention, illegal interrogation methods, physical and psychological torture, inhumane detention conditions, violation of rights to a fair trial, years of solitary confinement, unreasonably high sentences, intentional health neglect leading to death or permanent disability, and violations of children's rights, women and people with special needs, restricting visits, violating personal and religious rights, assaulting detainees' families, confiscating assets, demolishing homes, extending the prison term without justification, re-arresting after liberation, and other internationally documented crimes against detainees.
